# JCQ - Examination Conduct

The Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ) has strict rules on students conduct in examinations. To ensure students are fully prepared for this, all mock examinations replicate their code of conduct. This includes:

1. No use of mobile phones, smart watches or unauthorised electronic devices
2. Drinks must only be water and be in a clear unlabelled bottle
3. Student pencil cases must be clear
4. No writing or graffiti on hands, arms or clothing
5. Silence throughout the examination, including entering and exiting the hall.

# Destinations and Post 16

The entry criteria for Post 16 Sixth Form and Colleges continues to rise, with a student's GCSE results the primary factor in being successful with their application.

Students should begin their applications during Module 2, with their December Mock Examinations the primary indicator of their performance.

What are the stages of courses available for students:

Level 1: Academic challenge **is lower** than the course your child is currently taking.

Level 2: Academic challenge **is the same** as the course your child is currently taking.

Level 3: Academic challenge **is greater** than the course your child is currently taking, with a Level 3 qualification required to attend University.
